Applications need to include your student ID, what stage you are at in your law degree, any conjoint degrees, and a synopsis of relevant advocacy experience. Students must be at a minimum completing Contract and Torts this year (i.e. part two and doing or have done contract law).

A shortlist will be invited to undertake trials which will be held Monday and Tuesday 25 and 26 September.

The team will be announced in early October.

The shortlist and the team will be chosen by the coaches in conjunction with the Dean and the Faculty.
